Praying for one Another

ARRAN

Arran Free Church has a morning service in Shiskine and an evening service in Brodick. The church seeks to minister the Word and provide pastoral care for its members, but also to reach out to the wider community with the Gospel of Christ.

PRAYER POINTS

MERKINCH

Merkinch is among the most deprived areas in Scotland despite being less than two miles away from one of the wealthiest areas of Inverness. This scheme is a close-knit community. However, Merkinch struggles with high crime rates, mental health problems (bottom 0.2% for overall health in Scotland), and poor education. The Free North has partnered with 20 Schemes in planting the Merkinch Free Church. We desire to see "A local church for local people with local leadership".

PRAYER POINTS
