K-1st Grade - (Need 1 Teacher on rotation schedule) In our K-1st-grade class we use a curriculum called, *The Gospel Project*. You will be provided with the material, which includes DVDs, activities, and games for our children as they learn the basic blocks in God's great story of redemption. Expect to prepare 30 minutes-1

hour a week. Also, arrive at 8:50 am to receive children as they arrive in your class.

2-4th Grade - (Need 2 Teachers on rotation schedule) In our 2-4th grades class we also use the Gospel Project. You will be provided with the material, which includes DVDs, activities, and games for our children as they learn how the Old and New Testament connects to Christ in God's great story of redemption. Expect to prepare 30 minutes-1 hour a week. Also, arrive at 8:50 am to receive children as they arrive in your class.

Kids K-4th - (Need 2 Floaters/Subs on weekly rotation) These superstars will rotate each week to fill needs as they arise during the 9:09 am Small Group hour. There are times where families have emergencies or are out of town and can't be there to serve. You will be our go-to person. You will be contacted if/when the need arises when it is your week.

Check In Team (Need 2 to be on a once-every-5 week-rotation)

Greet Children/Parents as they check-in in the morning. Arrive at 8:50am to set up the computer system and help families check-in.

Kids Team (Need 4 Support Team Members on weekly rotation)

You will support the Kids Teacher during Kids Worship by guiding and supervising our children during the teaching time and activity time. You will lead a simple game for the kids that help drive the main point of the lesson home. Arrive at 10:15 am to receive children in the classroom. Very minimal prep time. Less than 30 minutes when it's your week.

Kids K-4th (Need 2 Floaters/Subs on weekly rotation)

Security Team (Mike ______) - Serve your church family and visitors by being available outside and/or inside to provide security while services are held. Teams serve on a rotating schedule.

VBS (Sammi) – Vacation Bible School

VBS is a ministry to spread the gospel of Jesus to local children and reach their families during this energy-filled, high-excitement, amazing week! Classes range from 4 year old's to adult. It is a week-long ministry that occurs in June and it is a great opportunity for church members to serve our community.

Willing Hands (Connie) – Sew items for nursing homes, pregnancy care centers, homeless, and others in need. *Do not have to sew – other opportunities available.* Men and women are welcome and serve in this ministry. Not limited to SRBC members. Meet every other Monday (Jan-June and Aug-Nov) in FH at 3:00pm and eat at 5:30pm (come when you can).

Worship Ministry (Angie Worship Teams, and Worship through Choir, Band, Worship Teams, and Audiovisual Team. Choir practice each Sunday in Choir Room at 5pm. Choir takes the summer off from June – August. Band and Worship Team practice each Wednesday in Worship Center with Audiovisual Team, 6:00p-7:00p (specific worship team practice will vary depending on weekly rotation). Requirements to be on the Worship Team: must be SRBC member and Choir member.

Do you care about their spiritual well-being and their physical needs as they arise? The SRBC Constitution allows for a man who has been a member for one year, exceeds 21 years of age, and meets the qualifications of 1 Timothy 3 to present himself to the deacon body. Church Elected Committees¹

Audio/Visual Committee: Work with the music director for audio quality during worship and special services. Help produce quality video recordings. Facilitate requests for recordings of worship services.

Baptism Committee: work with the pastor to ensure candidates are prepared and with the buildings and grounds committee to ensure the facilities (baptistery, towels, robes if necessary) are prepared.

Buildings & Grounds Committee: make periodic inspections of the buildings and equipment owned and operated by the church; partake in the work and advise in budgetary requests for B&G updates/upkeep.

¹¹You can be elected by our church after being nominated by the nominating committee after one year of membership. However, the respective committee chairpersons may approve your partnering with them in a non-official standing.

Decoration Committee: decorate the facilities in manners suitable to seasons and holidays and assist with the ambiance surrounding funerals at SRBC.

Kitchen Committee: Maintain supplies, kitchen equipment, assist in the preparation and serving of food for church activities.

Transportation Committee: Maintain and administer vehicle operations; Perhaps be willing to secure the proper credentials to drive for church functions

Nursery/Preschool: Provide care during worship times once a quarter or teach the 3 and 4 year olds during the same worship hour. This is also needed during small group time.

Missions Committee: Assist in facilitating the sending and support of missionaries to carry out the Great Commission; Promote resources and programs to educate and motivate the members.

Youth Planning Committee: Assist in providing chaperones for activities; Encourage youth to participate in activities—which begins with assuring your own children's participation.
