Plan to Memorize Psalm 1

Day One: Read Psalm 1:1 out loud ten times, looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Then cover the verse and recite it ten times. You're done for the day.

Day Two: Monday's verse first! Recite yesterday's verse, Psalm 1:1 ten times. Look at the verse if you need to, just to refresh your memory. Next, do the new verse. Read Psalm 1:2 our loud ten times, looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Then cover the page and recite that verse ten times. You're done for the day.

Day Three: Tuesday's verse first. Recite Psalm 1:2 ten times. Look at the verse to refresh your memory as needed. Old verses next, altogether: Recite Psalm 1:1-2 together one time. On to the new verse, read Psalm 1:3 out loud ten times, looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Cover the page and recite Psalm 1:3 ten times. You're done for the day.

Day four: Yesterday's verse first. Recite Psalm 1:3 ten times. Look at the verse only to refresh your memory. Old verses next: Recite Psalm 1:1-3 together one time. Now, do the new verse. Read Psalm 1:4 out loud ten times looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Cover the page and recite Psalm 1:4 ten times. You're done for the day

Day Five: Yesterday's verse first. Recite Psalm 1:4 ten times. Look at the verse only to refresh your memory. Old verses next: Recite Psalm 1:1-4 together one time. Now, do the new verse. Read Psalm 1:5 out loud ten times looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Cover the page and recite Psalm 1:5 ten times. You're done for the day

Day Six: Yesterday's verse first. Recite Psalm 1:5 ten times. Look at the verse only to refresh your memory. Old verses next: Recite Psalm 1:1-5 together one time. Now, do the new verse. Read Psalm 1:6 our loud ten times looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Cover the page and recite Psalm 1:6 ten times. You're done for the day

Day Seven: Yesterday's verse first. Recite Psalm 1:6 ten times. Look at the verse only to refresh your memory. Old verses next: Recite Psalm 1:1-6 together one time. You're done for the day. Psalm 1 should now be in your memory forever. Check yourself on it from time to time.
